Church Spotlight-Jenny Fagg

Jenny M. Fagg was born in Oklahoma City, OK into a family with two brothers and a sister. Her brothers are now deceased and her sister lives in Normangee, TX. They moved around and ended up in Burkburnett, TX, north of Wichita Falls. From there they moved to Houston in 1944 where she attended Reagan High School and met Clint Fagg who would be her husband of 48 years. Clint's family had moved to Houston the same year. They dated through High School. She started attending the Church of Christ in high school with Clint. She grew up attending the Christian Church. In 1948 they were married at the Twenty-six and North Shepherd congregation (which is now the Shady Acers congregation). They have three children: a son, Clint Fagg, III, and daughters Cynthia Krohn (a member at Southwest Central) and Karen Montgomery.



She also has eight grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. They came to Southwest Church of Christ in 1957 at the invitation of Evelyn Cox, she said that "we have a nursery." With a new baby that was important. Having worshiped with our congregation for over 50 years, Jenny loves the inclusiveness that we have. She is also very pleased with the overall direction of the church.

Jenny is life member of the National Genealogical Society and has published several genealogical books, including *The Family History of Thomas Martin, Sr., a North Carolinian American Revolutionary Soldier* about a distant relative.
