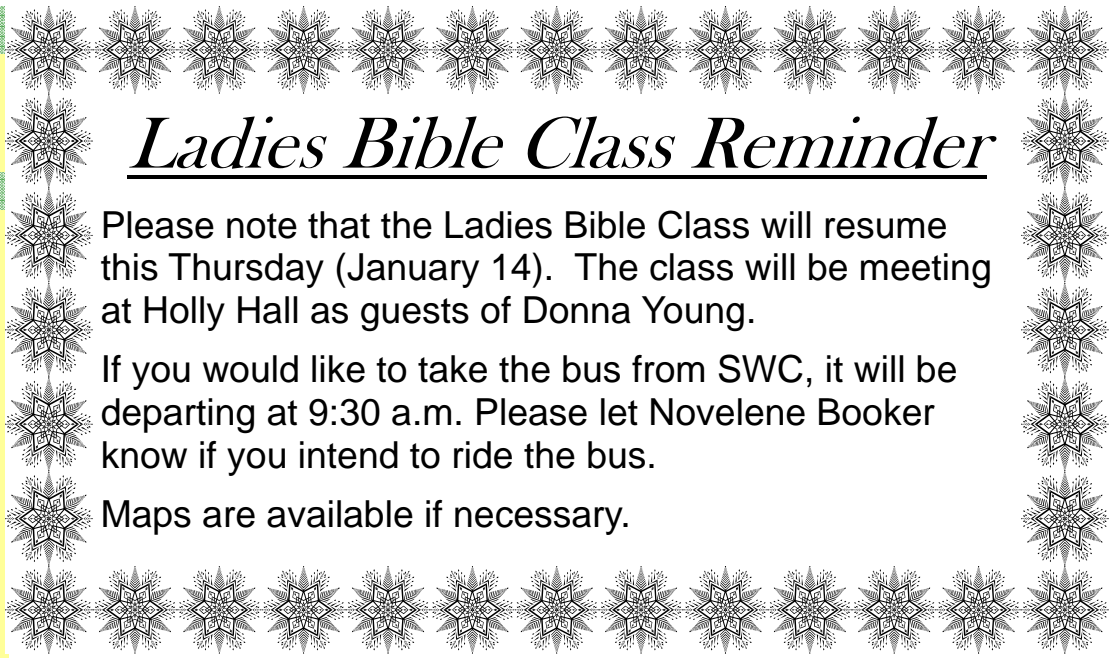

You are invited to hear two pioneering American missionaries who have spent almost fifty years sowing the seed in the Philippines. As servants in His kingdom, they are rare gems!

Bob Buchanan and Ken Wilkey are both graduates of ACU in the 1950's. Please come and be inspired by their stories and their experiences. They will talk about how mission work has transformed from covering a few places in a country to planning to go into all the cities of the whole country. The principles they are going to present are universal that will apply to any country in the world, as the Lord envisioned it in the Great Commission. Our speakers also have done mission work and traveled to many countries such as Burma, Cambodia, Africa, Germany, United Kingdom, Chile, Mexico, Honduras, and many more.
