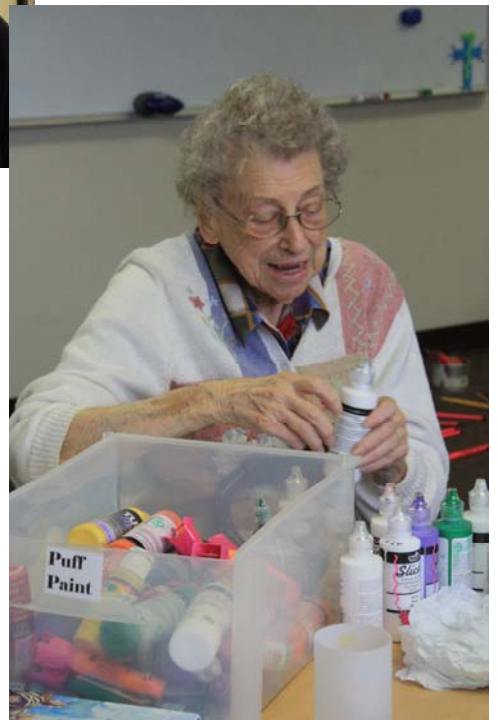

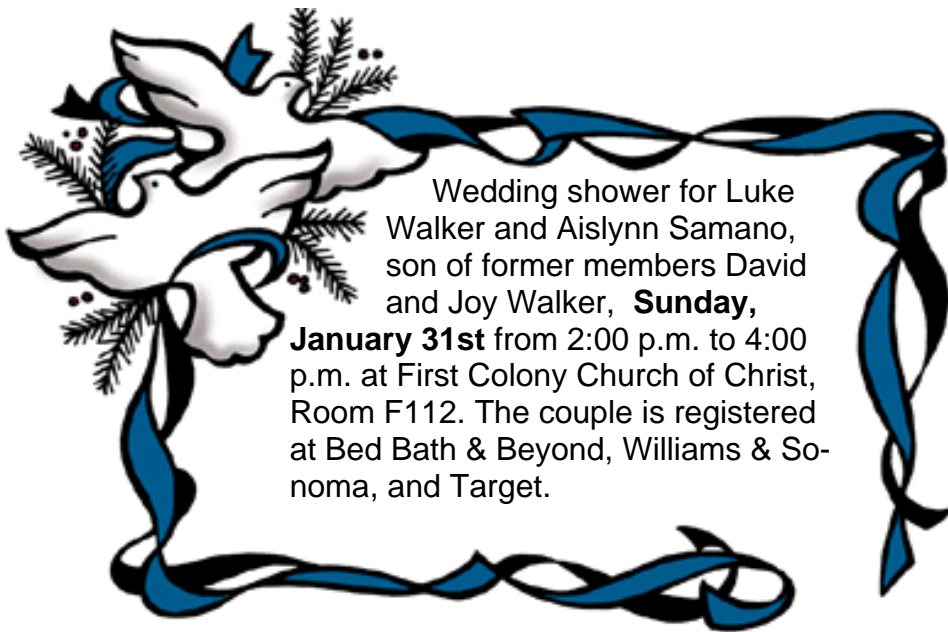


Souper Bowl of Caring 2010

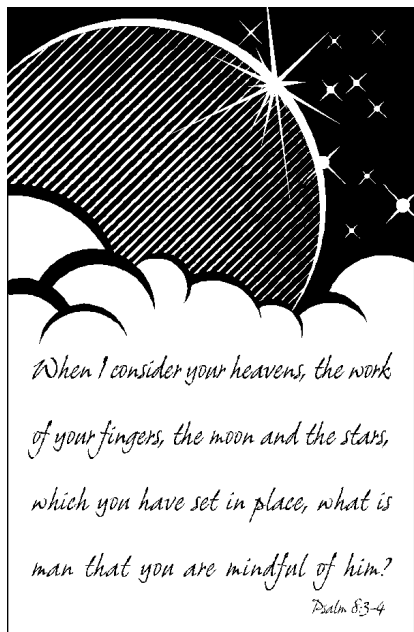
